Typical Workflow

1. Verify you are working on the correct entity (Customer/Account/Service).
2. Review the current lifecycle state before making changes.
3. Apply changes and validate system response.
4. Confirm downstream impact (AAA/Provisioning/Billing) where applicable.

Field & Action Hints (Auto-detected)

- **Fields detected:** Advertisement Allowed, Hotspot Name, Captive Portal, Latitude, Longitude, Select Partner, Default Country Code, Key, Description, Select All, One Time Use, Time Duration, Never Expires
- **Actions detected:** Auto, Close, WiFi, Hotspot, Create Hotspot, Cancel

Validation & Safety Checks

- Confirm identifiers before saving.
- Confirm lifecycle state allows the change.
- Confirm rollback/support path exists for production actions.

Escalation Guidance
